This loan will also fund transmission expansions and upgrades, and the construction of warehouse and headquarters facilities throughout the reservation. The funding will be used to acquire 5,337 consumers and build 144 miles of transmission line and 221 miles of distribution line near Tuba City (owned by Arizona Public Service) and on the Hopi Reservation. This loan includes \$29,412,189 in smart grid technologies throughout the system. This includes 304 miles of backbone fiber and 27 miles of customer drops. Navajo Tribal Utility Authority is headquartered in Fort Defiance, Ariz., serving approximately 41,500 accounts, over 10,698 miles of line in six counties in Arizona, Utah, and New Mexico.

This loan includes \$18,828,503 in various smart grid projects, including the installation of 200 miles of fiber backbone. Warren RECC, headquartered in Bowling Green, Ky., serves nearly 68,000 members over 5,753 miles in Barren, Butler, Edmonson, Grayson, Logan, Ohio, Simpson and Warren counties.

The three projects include: Caribou Solar, a 964.6 kilowatt project in Caribou; Dirt Solar, a 3,937 kilowatt project in Skowhegan; and Freeport Solar, a 982.2 kilowatt project in Fairfield.

It provides wholesale electric power to 11 distribution cooperatives serving nearly 137,000 consumer accounts in a 34,500-square-mile area in eastern North Dakota and northwestern Minnesota.

It serves 48,163 customers through 5,541 miles of line in nine counties in South Carolina.

This loan includes \$3,946,600 in smart grid technologies, including the installation of 45 miles of fiber-optic communication lines. Northern Neck Electric, headquartered in Warsaw, Va., serves 19,136 consumers over 2,160 miles of line in six counties in Virginia's Northern Neck region.
