USDA Rural Development Accepting Applications for its Multi-Family Preservation and Revitalization (MPR) Program

The Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for USDA Rural Development's Multi-Family Preservation and Revitalization (MPR) demonstration program was recently published in the Federal Register. Pre-applications for the program are due by 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on Monday, November 24th.

A total of \$20 million is available nationwide to help with making repairs and improvements at apartment complexes participating in USDA Rural Development's Rural Rental Housing program.
