

30-Day Final Notice for Areas Changing from Rural to Non-rural

On June 4, 2018, the following changes to Rural Development's eligible rural areas for Single Family Housing and Multi-Family Housing will be effective:

- 1) Lake County – Increase the ineligible area south of Crown Point near the intersection of I-65 and State Road 8 to square up the ineligible area.
- 2) Elkhart County – Increase the ineligible area on the east side of Elkhart between State Road 120 and US 20 due to annexation by the city of Elkhart. The area was squared up with a county road as a boundary.
- 3) Grant County – Increase the ineligible area to include areas recently annexed by the city of Marion.
- 4) Howard County – Increase the ineligible area to include an area east of Kokomo bordering on US-31 due to annexation by the city of Kokomo. The area was squared up to follow a county road.
- 5) Tippecanoe County – increase the ineligible area around Lafayette and West Lafayette to include recent annexations by these cities.
- 6) Hamilton County –
 - a. Increase the ineligible area northwest of Westfield to include recent annexation by Westfield.
 - b. Increase the ineligible area east of Noblesville and Fishers due to annexations by these cities and to square up the boundary line.
- 7) Madison County – Increase the ineligible area south of Anderson by I-69 due to annexation by the city of Anderson and to square up the area by making the boundary a county road.
- 8) Wayne County – Increase the ineligible area west of Richmond by I-70 due to annexation by the city of Richmond.
- 9) Shelby County – increase the ineligible area around Shelbyville due to annexations by the city of Shelbyville.
- 10) Hendricks County – Increase the ineligible area west of Plainfield due to annexation by the city of Plainfield.
- 11) Monroe County – Increase in the ineligible area north of Bloomington off State Road 37 due to annexation by the city of Bloomington.
- 12) Bartholomew County – Increase the ineligible area around Columbus due to annexations by the city of Columbus.
- 13) Clark County – Increase the ineligible area around Jeffersonville due to annexations by the city of Jeffersonville.
