USDA Rural Development in Southern New England operates more than 50 financial assistance programs to support rural areas in Connecticut, Massachusetts and Rhode Island. We provided \$491.8 million in direct loans, guaranteed loans and grants in Fiscal Year 2015.




More than \$52 million in Community Facilities grants and loans supporting rural schools, fire, police, hospitals and public services.




Over \$382 million in Single Family Direct and Guaranteed Lending giving more than 1,900 rural families the opportunity to own a piece of the American Dream.



More than \$8 million in Business and Industry grants and loans to rural business creating jobs and opportunities for economic growth.




Over than \$16 million in Water and Environmental Programs grants and loans investing in rural water and sewer infrastructure.



Over \$21 million in Rental Assistance to support the residents of 145 multi-family apartment complexes in our three-state region, helping to bring their monthly rent costs below 30% of their monthly income.



More than \$3.4 million in renewable energy investments estimated to save or generate 5.67 million kwh annually, enough to power more than 523 homes for a year.



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
