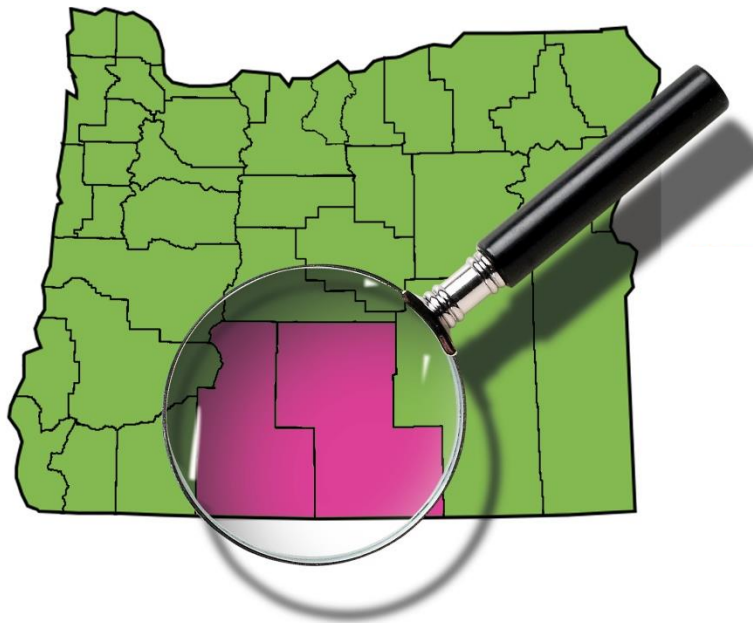




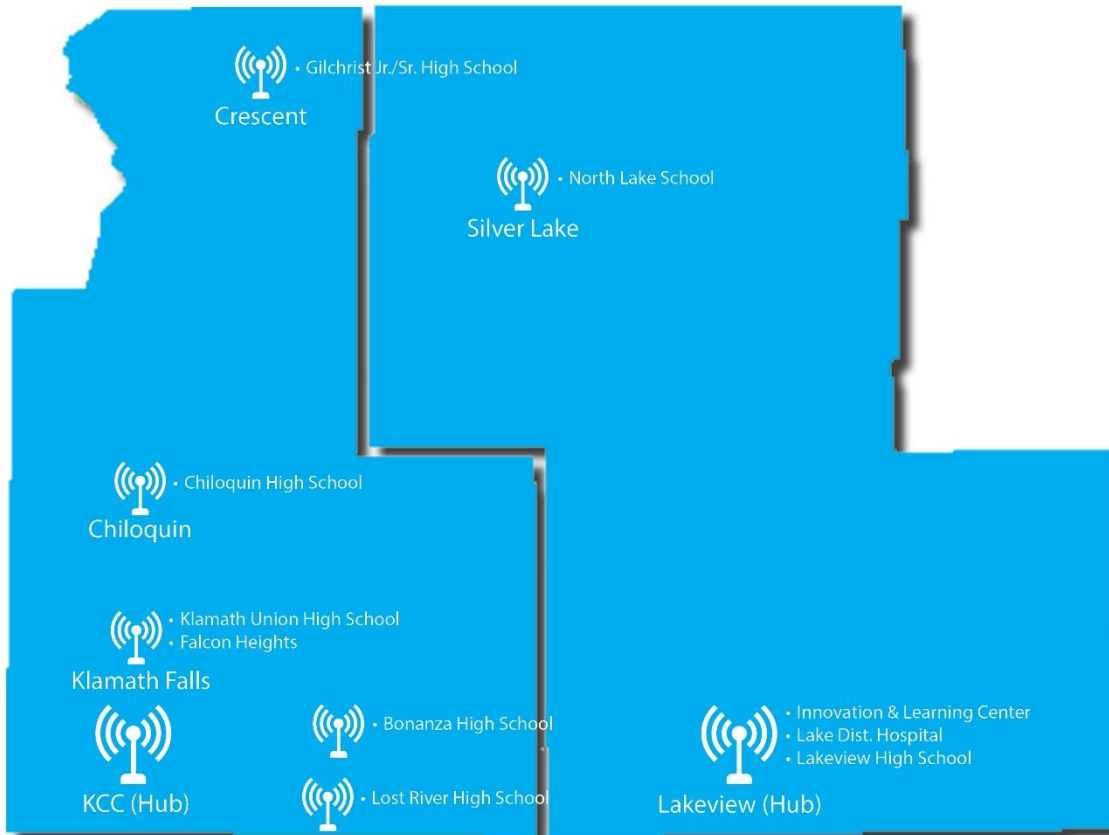

Innovation Learning Center- KCC Lakeview

- Fall 2013, KCC-Lake County students (synchronous, in-person, online) earned a total of **310** credits
- Fall 2014, students earned **472** credits.
- Fall 2015 students earned **503** credits.
- Winter 2016 credit count came in at **613** credits



Effects of Synchronous Efforts -

KCC increased dual credit students from 544 to 840
(a 54% increase in one year!)


The Future of KCC Synchronous classrooms at KCC -
