## Solar System Helps Potts Harbor Lobster Produce Clean, Reliable Electricity

Potts Harbor Lobster, in Harpswell, utilized a USDA Rural Development **Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) Grant** in the amount of \$11,750 to install a solar photovoltaic system.

The new system makes Potts Harbor Lobster Maine's only solar commercial working waterfront. The newly installed system is expected to produce over 13,000 kWh of clean, reliable electricity a year, and reduce its carbon footprint by 20K pounds of CO<sub>2</sub> annually.
