Bowman Market, Inc. <i>Bowman, ND</i>	\$101,366	The project funds will purchase and install energy efficient refrigeration, freezers, and LED lighting. The annual savings is estimated at \$9,890 and will save 120,387 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 11 homes.
Dakota Valley Electric Cooperative <i>Edgeley, ND</i>	\$47,311	The project funds will purchase and install energy efficient LED lighting. The annual savings is estimated at \$2,935 and will save 96,086 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 8 homes.
Northern Plains Electric Cooperative <i>Carrington, ND</i>	\$47,311	The project funds will purchase and install energy efficient LED lighting. This annual savings is estimated at \$2,935 and will save 96,086 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 8 homes.
Burnt Creek Nursery <i>Baldwin, ND</i>	\$43,189	The project funds will purchase and install a direct use geothermal heating and cooling system. The annual savings is estimated at \$6,570 and will save 114,601 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 10 homes.
White Buffalo Foods, Inc. <i>Fort Yates, ND</i>	\$42,261	The project funds will purchase and install energy efficient refrigeration, freezers, and LED lighting. The annual savings is estimated \$15,332 and will save 74,372 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 6 homes.
McLean Electric Cooperative <i>Garrison, ND</i>	\$31,618	The project funds will purchase and install energy efficient LED lighting. The annual savings is estimated at \$7,482 and will save 116,905 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 10 homes.
Basin Auto Parts, Inc. <i>Beulah, ND</i>	\$14,076	The project funds will purchase and install energy efficient LED lighting, updated heating & cooling system, and additional insulation. The annual savings estimated at \$7,006 and will save 109,371 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 10 homes.
DCMC Properties, LLP <i>Taylor, ND</i>	\$4,798	The project funds will purchase and install energy efficient LED lighting. The annual savings is estimated at \$4,098 and will save 40,878 kWh per year, which is enough electricity to power 3 homes.
