GA	City of Eatonton	\$1,000,000		Funds will be used to help Vizitech USA, LLC, a 3D technology company, pay operating expenses, purchase equipment and expand operations. The project will create 20 jobs.
IA	Scranton Telephone Company	\$1,000,000		Funds will be used to help Scranton Manufacturing expand its manufacturing facility. The project will create about 70 jobs.
IA	Sully Telephone Association	\$272,000		Funds will be used to make street and water infrastructure improvements for Sully, Iowa's industrial business park and facilitate expansion of Janco Industries. The project will create 56 jobs.
IL	Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative	\$2,000,000		Funds will be used to help Mattoon Precision Manufacturing, an automotive parts manufacturer, expand its manufacturing and warehousing facilities. The project will create 16 jobs and save 4 others.
IL	Corn Belt Energy	\$2,000,000		Funds will be used to help Patriot Fuels Biodiesel, LLC purchase equipment for a 4-million-gallon-per- year biodiesel plant they are constructing. The project will create 9 jobs.

NC	Piedmont Electric Membership Cooperative		\$237,500	Funds will be used to finance a new water tanker truck for the Eno, N.C. fire department.
ND	Roughrider Electric Cooperative	\$300,000		Funds will be used to help KinderKidz Learning Center, LLC expand its existing child daycare facility. The project will create 10 jobs.
SC	Pee Dee Electric Cooperative	\$1,000,000		Funds will be used to provide Barth, Inc., dba Red Bone Alley, with working capital and funds for renovations, training and equipment. The project will create or save about 101 jobs.

TN	Tri-County Electric Membership Corporation	\$1,000,000		Funds will be used to help the Allen County-Scottsville Industrial Development Authority construct a 48,000-square-foot manufacturing building for lease to Sumitomo Electric Wiring Systems, Inc. The project will create about 25 jobs.
UT	City of Price		\$300,000	Funds will be used to help Utah State University remodel and construct an educational facility for its criminal justice, communications, art, music, theater and general education programs.
