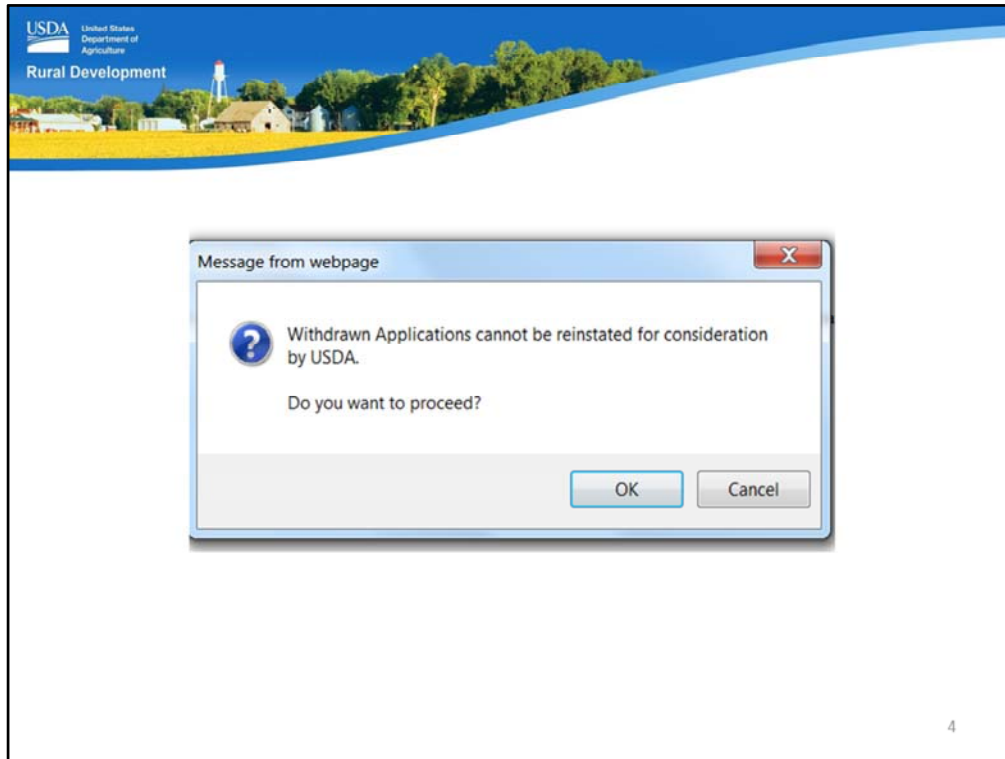

Lender Agents may also withdraw an application from consideration from the selected Approved USDA lender to which it was sent.



When “Withdraw Application” is selected a pop up box will appear that states: “Withdrawn Applications cannot be reinstated for consideration by USDA. Do you want to proceed.?”

Select “Ok” to process the withdraw of the loan application in GUS.

Select “Cancel” to exit the pop up box without withdrawing the loan application.
