

Utah Progress Summary

In fiscal year 2016, USDA Rural Development invested **\$476,565,834** into rural Utah communities.

Rural Business Programs

In FY 2016, USDA Rural Development supported Utah's rural businesses with **\$23.5 million** in loan and grant for 29 projects, including renewable energy and energy efficiency improvements. Business and Cooperative Programs serve Utah's communities by creating new business, growing production, creating and maintaining jobs, conducting feasibility studies/business plans, improving rural energy development, increasing revenue for rural business ventures, and strengthening rural access to capital.

Rural Community Programs and Utility Services

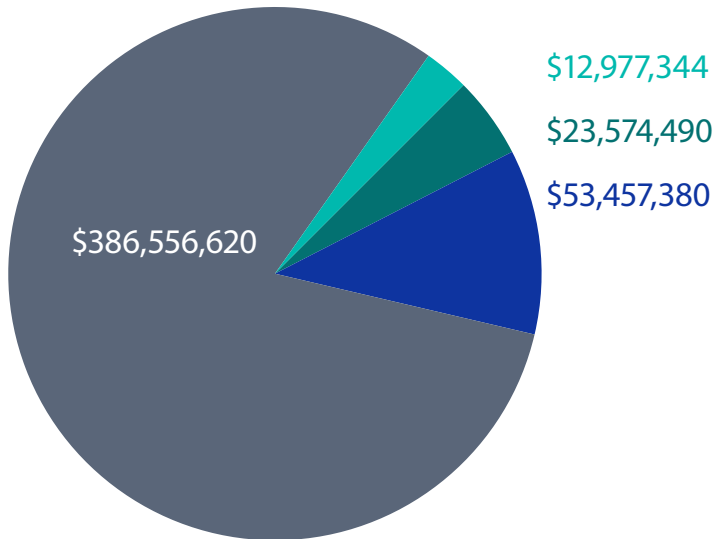
We invested **\$53.4 million** in rural Utah through community facilities loans and grants. The 13 projects included funding for rural health care, education, public safety improvement, and dependent care services. Community Facilities Programs help build, expand, rehabilitate, purchase, and support the development of police and emergency fire stations and equipment, museums, child care centers, hospitals, clinics, schools, and more.

USDA Rural Development also invested **\$9.6 million** for six projects to provide reliable and clean drinking water, waste treatment systems, and telecommunications services.

Rural Housing Programs

USDA Rural Development provided **\$ 386.5 million** in loans and grants to build, repair, rehabilitate, and purchase homes that ultimately improve the quality of life in rural Utah. Rural Development provides funding for single-family homes, apartments for lower-income families or the elderly, and housing for farm laborers. In fiscal year 2016, the agency obligated 1,903 loans to finance homes for families in rural Utah communities.

What started as a backyard beekeeping hobby for Mindy Waite and her family has grown into Harvest Lane Honey, an influential local business manufacturing and selling beekeeping supplies out of Tooele, Utah. To help them get started, Waite received a loan from the Utah Small Business Loan Fund, a partner organization to USDA Rural Development. The Small Business Loan Fund has participated in USDA's Intermediary Relending Program, which supports small rural businesses.
