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SUBJECT: Financing Veterans of Foreign Wars Projects Using Community
Facilities Funds

PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME:

This Administrative Notice (AN) is being issued to provide guidance to Rural Development staff regarding financing of Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) and American Legion (AL) post projects with Community Facilities (CF) loan or grant funds. This AN clarifies the eligibility requirements associated with essential community facilities.

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN:

This AN replaces RD AN No. 4755 (1942-A, 3570-B and 3575-A) dated March 11, 2014, which expired on March 31, 2015.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:

While the specific activities of a VFW or AL post may vary from region to region, there are some similarities that need to be consistent to be considered an essential community facility. The VFW and AL post projects must meet all eligibility criteria for CF funding, especially being open and available for use by appointment or lease to community residents or community groups. The projects must improve the quality of life for rural residents.
