## Certification Under section 1511 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

Pursuant to Title XV, Subtitle A, section 1511 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L.111-5(Feb. 17 2009)) ( "ARRA" ) I, Robert Hickey, City Administrator for the City of Gridley,, hereby certify that the following infrastructure investment has received the full review and vetting required by law and that I accept responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. I further certify that the specific information required by Section 1511 concerning these investments is as follows:

The project consists of the rehabilitation/upgrade of the existing Wastewater Treatment Plant (WTP) to alleviate potential human health and environmental problems through the conversion of the existing facility to a high-rate head-works facility and to perform improvements to piping, electrical and support facilities. The proposed Randolph Avenue Sewer Main portion of the project will consist of bypass and abandonment of an existing sewer pump station located at the intersection of Laurel Street and Randolph Avenue from Laurel Street to Little Avenue and consists of replacing of approximately 1,920 lf of 10-inch diameter sewer pipe; sewer manholes; sewer laterals; removal of existing sewer pump station and furnishing, installing, operating and removal of dewatering facilities. The Sycamore Street Sewer Main Replacement portion of the project will consist of replacement of approximately 3,500 lf of 10-inch diameter sewer pipe; sewer manholes; connection to existing sewer mains; sewer laterals and furnishing, installing, operating and removal of dewatering facilities. All project activities are within the sphere of influence of the City of Gridley and existing road rights-of-way or utility corridors.

The total estimated cost of the project: \$5,050,850

I understand that the City of Gridley may not receive infrastructure investment funding from funds made available in this Act unless this certification is made and posted.
