State and local government recipients of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grants and loans must certify that the ARRA investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. As part of the Transparency and Oversight Requirements, section 1511 of ARRA, *Certifications*, requires "the mayor or other chief executive, as appropriate, "to"certify that the infrastructure investment has received the full review and vetting required by law and that the chief executive accepts responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars."

A State or local government agency may not receive infrastructure investment funding from funds made available under ARRA unless the certification is made and posted.

All State and local governments receiving ARRA funds shall complete the attached Certification form. The completed form, signed by the chief executive, must be returned to the Rural Development Area Office. The Area Office will obtain the signed Certification form and forward it to the Rural Development State Office, attention Linda Bowman. The Rural Development State Office will post the certification on the USDA RD SharePoint.
