SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the Rural Utilities Service (RUS), as required by the National Environmental Policy Act, is issuing an environmental assessment (EA) in connection with possible impacts related to a project proposed by Central Electric Power Cooperative (CEPC), of Osage and Maries Counties, Missouri. The proposal is for the rebuilding of the 161KV transmission lines between the Chamois, Rich Fountain, Vienna and Maries Substations. CEPC has submitted an application to the RUS for funding of the proposal.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: CEPC proposes rebuilding the transmission line on the existing right-of-way (ROW), with the lengths as follows. Chamois to Rich Fountain transmission line is 16.44 miles. Rich Fountain to Vienna transmission line is 20.62 miles. Vienna to Maries transmission line is 11.69 miles. CEPC is proposing to replace the existing wood structures with new H-frame wood structures that would be approximately 52 to 88 feet tall with a span between structures of approximately 700 to 800 feet.

CEPC prepared an environmental assessment for RUS that describes the project, assesses the proposed project's environmental impacts, and summarizes as applicable any mitigation measures used to minimize environmental effects. RUS has conducted an independent evaluation of the environmental assessment and believes that it accurately assesses the impacts of the proposed project. No significant impacts are expected as a result of the construction of the project.
