

## Checklist for Online Application System

### Higher Blends Infrastructure Incentive Program (HBIIP)

#### Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Number 10.754

- A Dun and Bradstreet Universal Numbering System (DUNS)/Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) number is required, unless the applicant is an individual. A DUNS/UEI number can be obtained at no cost via a toll-free request line at 1-866-705-5711 or online at <http://fedgov.dnb.com/webform>.
- Register the DUNS/UEI# at [www.sam.gov](http://www.sam.gov). Include the CAGE code & expiration date as part of a complete application.
- Create a USDA E-Authentication Customer Account, <https://www.eauth.usda.gov>. Level 2 access is recommended.
- A Company may request access to *HBIIP Online Application System* by emailing a written request and a completed **HBIIP Access Request** to, [HigherBlendsGrants-access@usda.gov](mailto:HigherBlendsGrants-access@usda.gov)
  - Please allow at least 2 business days to process your request;
  - Upon approval, a Company's authorized/rightful users will each receive an email from, [RD.AdminAppsSupport@usda.gov](mailto:RD.AdminAppsSupport@usda.gov), with, a URL and instructions to access the system.
  - Copy the URL and paste it into the address bar of a **Google Chrome** internet browser and hit enter.
  - Bookmark the URL for future use.

NOTE: Depending on your specific email client settings, the email may be placed into a Spam folder.
- The Online Application System (OAS) is scheduled for delivery Friday, May 15, 2020, at which time;
- A **Solicitation of Applications** to announce officially the beginning and ending dates of the 90-day HBIIP application window will be published in the *Federal Register*.

- Open the **HBIP Online Application, Instructions and Users Guide**
  
- **Plan your work. Work your plan!** The average time to complete the HBIP application is estimated at 78 hours; much less of course for “Owners of 10 stations or fewer.” You may begin completing these required application elements while you await access to the OAS:
