USDA Announces New Leadership in Single Family Housing Programs

WASHINGTON, Feb. 8, 2018 – Assistant to the Secretary for Rural Development Anne Hazlett today announced Roger Glendenning will serve as Rural Development’s Deputy Administrator of Single Family Housing.

Glendenning has served as Rural Development’s Chief Financial Officer for the past five years. He started his career in housing and farm-related programs in 1987 with the Farmers Home Administration in Delaware and Maryland before moving to the Washington, D.C., headquarters in 1996. He has worked at headquarters in the capacity of Director of the Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loan Division (2001-2006), Chief Budget Officer (2007-2009), Budget Division Director (2010-2012) and Chief Financial Officer (2013-present).

As Rural Development’s Deputy Administrator of Single Family Housing, Glendenning will help make the Single Family Housing programs at Rural Development more effective and efficient. This leadership change will take effect March 5.
