## Rural Utilities Service Environmental Review Process McClellanville Transmission Line Proposal

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Rural Utilities Service (RUS) is considering providing financial assistance to Central Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (Central Electric) to construct a proposed 115 kV transmission line in Berkeley, Charleston, and/or Georgetown Counties, SC. The line would provide reliable power to Berkeley Electric Cooperative customers in the McClellanville area. Prior to making a decision to finance a proposal, RUS is required to complete an environmental review process in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Following an initial set of public and agency meetings held in December 2005, RUS decided to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the proposal. Because the proposal may cross the Francis Marion National Forest, the U.S. Forest Service is a cooperating agency.

The forthcoming EIS will assess potential impacts that the proposal may have on the human environment and may include:

- Land Use
- Plants & Wildlife
- Wetlands & Floodplains
- Cultural Resources & Historic Properties
- Human Health & Public Safety
- Socioeconomics
- Environmental Justice
- Visual

### Public Scoping Meetings and Hearings

The RUS NEPA process provides numerous opportunities for public review and submission of comments. Following the conclusion of the scoping period, RUS will evaluate comments and consult with agencies to develop the scope of issues that will be considered in the EIS. Public comments often identify local concerns about a proposal and may influence implementation of a decision.

The public scoping process serves multiple goals for the proposal, including:

- Solicitation of comments from the public & private organizations
- Receipt of new information about alternatives
- Identification of impacts that may be significant

### RIGHT OF WAY BROCHURE

#### I. Who is Central Electric Power Cooperative, Inc.?

*CENTRAL ELECTRIC is a not for profit Generating and Transmission Electric Cooperative that is located in Columbia, SC. Central is owned by the 20 electric distribution cooperatives of South Carolina. It has the legal responsibility of providing transmission electric power in a reliable manner to its member cooperatives.*

#### II. What is the purpose of this project?

*The McClellanville 115 kV Transmission line is to provide an adequate, reliable supply of electricity to the McClellanville area of South Carolina. To accomplish this, Central Electric must build a new 115 kV electric transmission line that will provide a source of electricity of high-voltage energy to a proposed Berkeley Electric Cooperative substation located on Highway 17 in McClellanville, SC.*

#### III. How will the final route selected?

*A comprehensive siting study is being conducted to determine the preferred route for the new line. This siting study involves a diligent evaluation of several possible corridors that would accomplish its responsibility to provide this transmission power. Environmental concerns, ecological, biological as well as land use and future land uses are carefully considered before a preferred corridor is selected. This process is an objective fair-minded approach conducted with acceptable RUS siting standards. In addition, Central Electric is inviting public input with several public meetings.*

#### IV. What is the acquisition process?

*The first phase of the acquisition process is the preferred corridor landowner contacts phase. This phase is known as the Survey Permitting Phase and it involves meetings with landowners to discuss the project in more detail. Once this process is completed, a centerline survey along with other studies, appraisals, timber cruises and title work are completed. You will then be visited by our representative with an acquisition package consisting of an easement, an offer, appraisal report and timber cruise. Our representative will be available to explain this process to you by personal contact so as to be able to entertain any questions you may have.*



**V. What is a right of way easement?**

*An easement is a legal document giving Central the right to construct and maintain an electric transmission line over a right of way strip crossing a portion of your property. The easement will be recorded in the county court house along with an Exhibit "A" (plat) delineating the exact location and dimensions of the acquisition.*

**VI. How much right of way is required?**

*Generally speaking the right of way needed for this type of line is 70' in width. However, in some instances it may be wider and/or narrower. Central only acquires the area necessary to comply with FERC and NESC rules and regulations to insure safety and reliability.*

**VII. Will I be paid for the right of way?**

*An offer of compensation will be made to you based on an appraisal by a state licensed real estate appraiser. You will be given a copy of this report as well as any applicable timber evaluation. Central considers its offer to you to be fair and objective as it is based on acceptable real estate valuation practices.*

**VIII. Can I use the right of way?**

*You may use the right of way as long as that use is approved by Central in advance. Of course, houses, structures, wells, and septic tanks are some uses that may conflict with the easement Central acquires from you. These type uses would not be allowed.*

**IX. What happens if I refuse to grant permission for survey?**

*Central will exhaust every effort to work with you on this project. However, in the event survey permission is refused, the file will be turned over to our legal department for handling. In order to proceed with the project, Central must conduct a survey and related studies and will seek relief from the courts to do so.*

**X. What happens if I cannot reach agreement to sell this right of way?**

*Again, Central will work most diligently with you in reaching a settlement acceptable to all parties. However, Central is a not for profit cooperative that is basically owned by the citizens of the state of South Carolina and has a responsibility to conduct its business in a fiscally acceptable manner. Only as a last resort will Central initiate condemnation actions.*

As our state develops the demand on our electric transmission grid increases. To meet those needs, Central must improve its transmission network to help ensure a continuous, reliable flow of electricity.

While the improvements to this system benefit everyone, construction of these new transmission lines does affect individual landowners. We do understand you may have questions and concerns. This brochure is to help you understand who we are, what we are trying to do and the process of our right of way acquisition program.

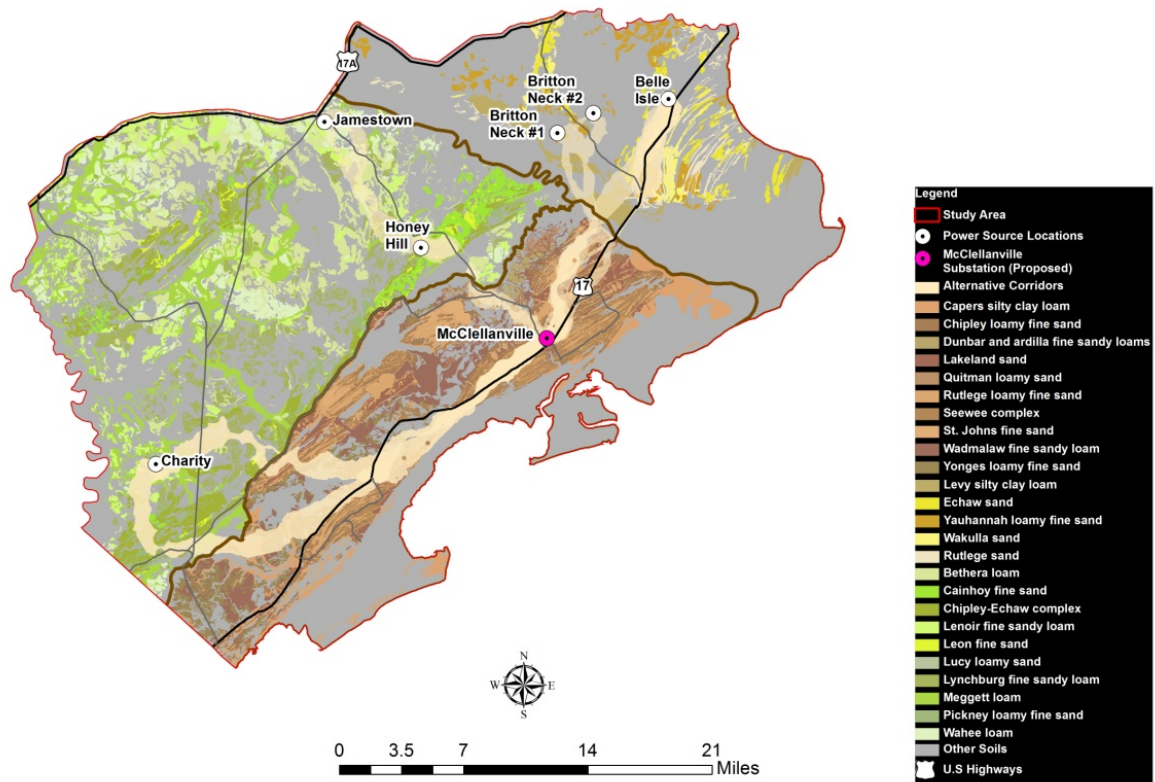

USGS 7.5' Quadrangle Map

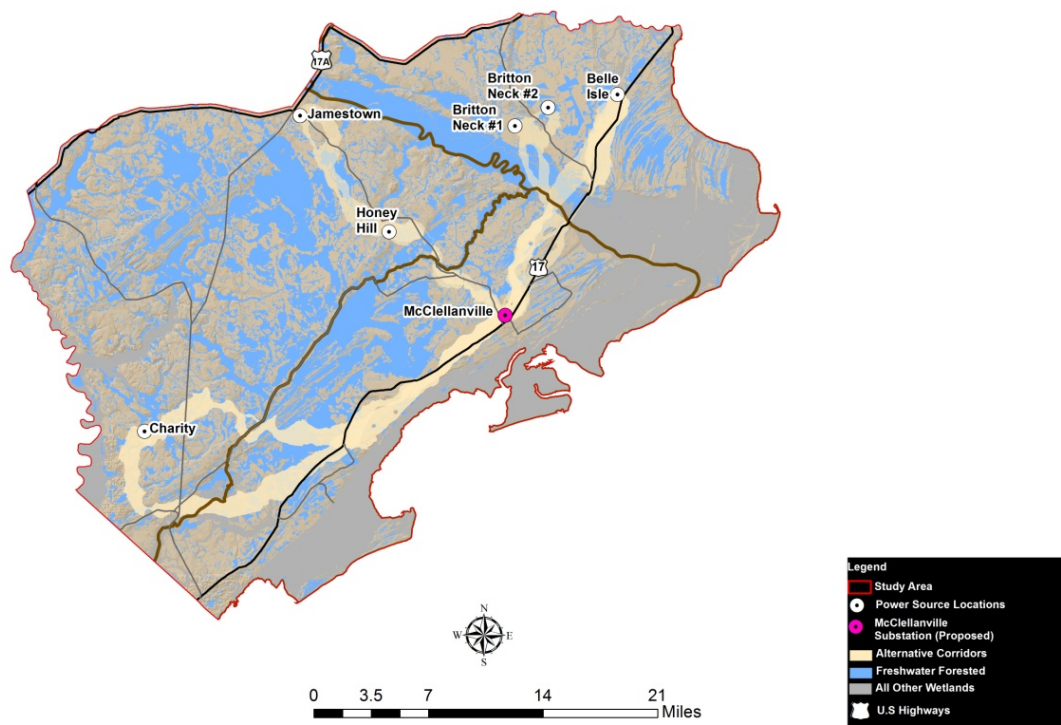

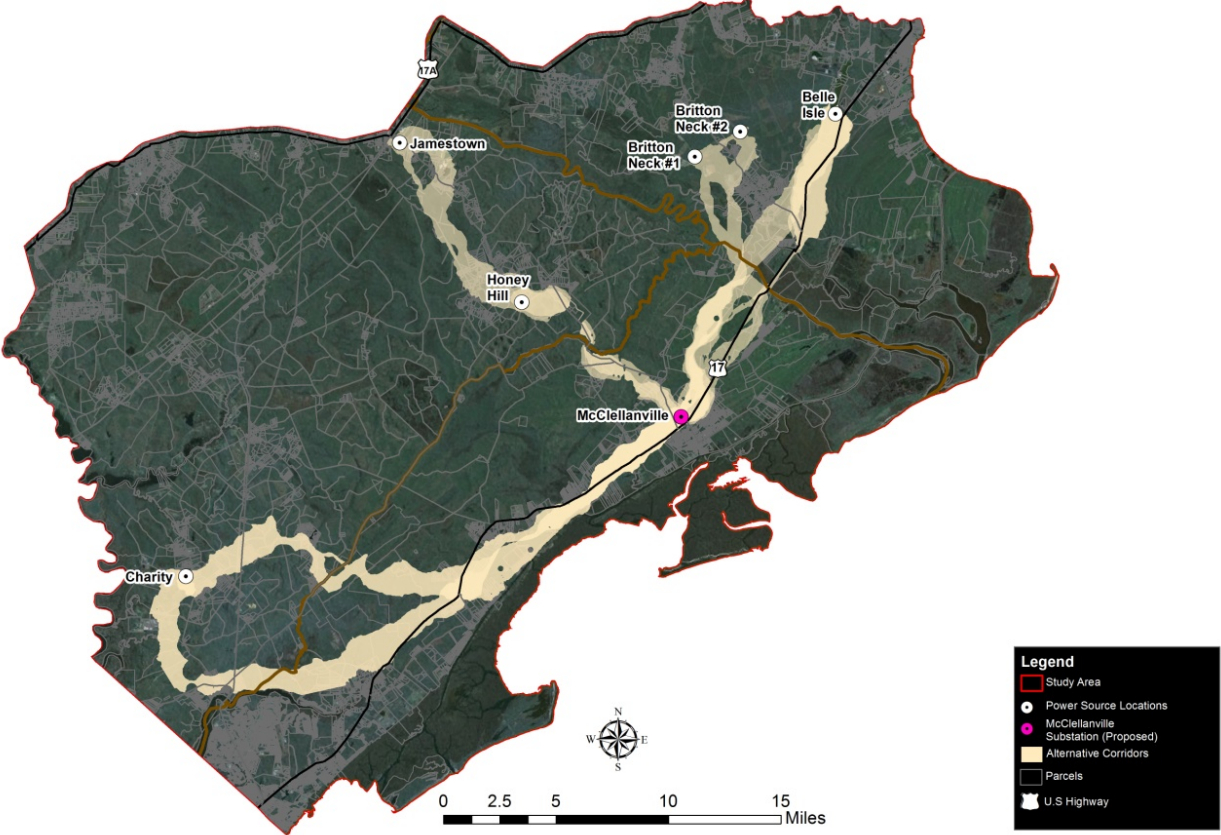
