Recent Agricultural Cooperative Statistics Reports

USDA collects cooperative statistical data from the population of U.S. agricultural cooperatives annually. Aggregated statistical results are published in an annual comprehensive statistical report, and as well, includes a section on the Top 100 cooperatives.

The agricultural statistics report with fiscal 2018 data has not been printed.
