## STAKEHOLDER ANNOUNCEMENT

**February 6, 2014** — A Rural Development borrower in Texas was the victim of telephone fraud and lost \$450. The caller said he worked for USDA Rural Development and offered the borrower a loan modification. The borrower was advised that there was a \$450 processing fee that must be paid through a WalMart Green Dot money coupon. The phone number the caller used was (585) 310-3069. This is a <a href="known scam">known scam</a> where the callers use different names and different banks through which to route the funds.

Rural Development employees who receive reports of similar calls/requests should inform borrowers that they are a scam and advise them not to pay. Borrowers who believe they have been contacted by a scammer should contact their <u>local Rural Development servicing office</u> so that our staff can report the incident to Federal security officials.
