



In some cases, cooperatives have jointly established trading organizations which are referred to under the heading "Commodities Exported." Some listings may include brands.

This directory lists 102 cooperatives or their marketing agencies that are capable of responding to inquiries and carrying out export transactions themselves or with third-party representation.
