## Healthy Families, Chatsworth Adds Pediatric Care, Doubles Patient Visits.

Healthy Families, Chatsworth is a community-based Federally Qualified Health Center providing health care services in an underserved area of rural north Georgia.

In 2018, with funds from the Health Resources & Services Administration, the center remodeled and reconfigured, adding pediatrics care and hired a pediatrician. USDA helped furnish a variety of equipment for the laboratory, exam rooms, patient rooms and waiting areas with \$100,000 from the <u>communi-</u> ty facilities direct loan and grant programs.

Families now have a local, affordable choice for pediatrics care. Previously, parents sought care for their children at the emergency room at Advent Health (formerly Murray Medical Center) or travelled to the nearest pediatrician 22 miles away in Dalton, Georgia.

In 2017, the center treated 921 children compared with 2018, they saw 2,224 children visits. Of the 2,224 visits, 16 percent were to children with no insurance and 56 percent had either Medicaid or Peachcare insurance. Healthy Families is a very welcoming and newly modernized facility filling the need for local health services. They are in an underserved area, serving the underserved.

USDA's community facilities program provides low interest loans and grants to purchase, construct and or improve essential community facilities, purchase equipment and pay related project expenses. For more information call (706) 546-2171.
