Jesse says "it was a miracle" they found the home in Oxford as quickly as they did. "If we hadn't been able to close when we did, we would have been homeless."

Jesse and Monique were elated to finance the home in Oxford through Residential Mortgage Services with a USDA Rural Development Single-Family Housing Guaranteed Loan. The best part is that their new home is affordable -- in fact, their mortgage payment of \$869 is less than their former rent payment of \$950. At the end of the day the pride they feel as a result of homeownership is priceless.

The family has big plans for their new home, and Jesse is currently renovating it so that each family member can have their own room. The large family room can easily accommodate them all, and a large yard and long driveway mean plenty of space for the kids to play and ride bikes.
