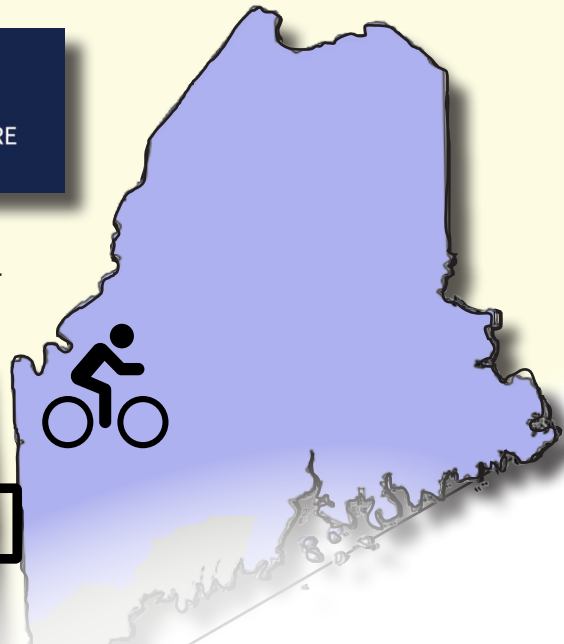
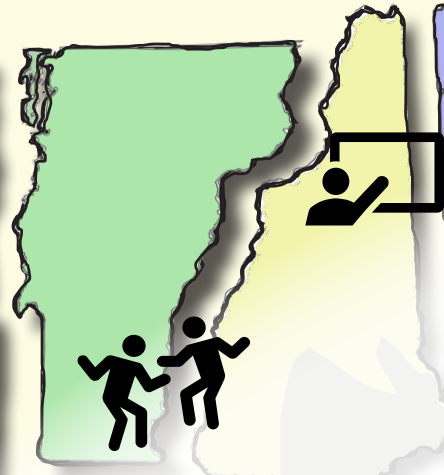
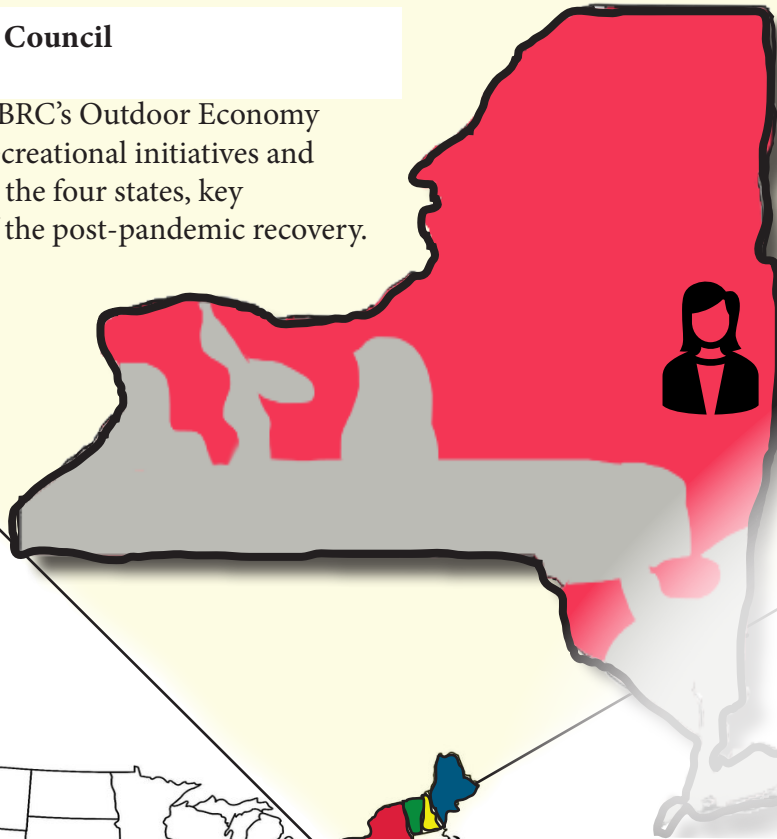


The NBRC and USDA-RD announced \$3 million in joint funding for economic-development projects in Maine, New Hampshire, New York and Vermont.

\$1,600,699

\$300,000



5.5 miles of bicycle-specific trail will create new connections for area residents and tourists. Increased activity will provide more opportunities for local economies to facilitate employee and business development.

University of New Hampshire

\$350,000



200-300 businesses in Carrol, Coos and Sullivan Counties will receive 1800-2000 hours of training over 3 years. The result? 15-20 new businesses and \$7-\$8 million in capital, with 150-200 jobs created or saved.
